

Preschool Residential Courses



Programme and organisation

Participants

Up to three families with Deaf/Hard of hearing preschoolers may attend each 3 day course. Families may need to share accommodation with the other families. Siblings and support adults may also be able to be accommodated for the course, at the discretion of the DHB who funds the course.

Programme

Rest, morning tea and lunch breaks will be scheduled.

Sunday

Arrive and settle into accommodation.

Monday

Meet the preschool course team and other families attending the course to discuss the focus for your family for the week.

Individual sessions with the team

Monday and Tuesday: 9am - 3pm Wednesday: 9am - 2pm

You will have the opportunity to join some of regular playgroup and preschool sessions with local children and families with Deaf/hard of hearing children.

Wednesday afternoon

Farewell: 2pm. Drive or fly home.

Travel

Transport to and from the course including transfers to and from the airport/bus/rail terminals is funded by your local DHB. Transfers to and from your home to your local airport will need to be organised and funded yourself. Accommodation and self-catering is covered by Ko Taku Reo.

What we offer

At Ko Taku Reo Deaf Education we offer a 3 day whānau centered programme tailored to you and your child's area of need and focus.

Activities and sessions may include:

- Support and guidance for understanding your child's language development (spoken and/or signed)
- Strategies for supporting language acquisition
- An introduction to Deaf culture, the use of visual communication and/or NZSL
- Audiology support and guidance to understand your child's hearing levels
- Sessions with an Early Literacy teacher on book sharing and strategies to develop early literacy skills
- Participate in the regular group sessions for local Christchurch or Auckland Deaf/ Hard of hearing preschoolers
- Meet and connect with other parents of Deaf/Hard of hearing preschoolers
